Each ATL school should select 25 students to participate in these sessions. ATL teachers must ensure the regular participation of selected students in online training. During the training week, students will learn about innovation, design thinking, prototype development, and problem-solving related to community needs. Based on the training, students should prepare projects and demonstrate addressing local community issues in their respective ATL.

## 2. ATL Community Day - 21st of April 2026

The 25 trained students will demonstrate their projects and innovations in their respective ATL laboratories. Students will explain their projects and showcase how these innovations can serve the community. Schools should invite parents, local community members, teachers, students of non-ATL schools and distinguished guests to attend the programme.

ATL should function as a community innovation hub, where students provide ideas and services beneficial to society. Schools should document the event and share a brief report along with photographs with the concerned office.

### **Directions for ATL Teachers...**

- Select 25 interested and capable students for participation in the training programme.
- Ensure timely attendance and active participation of students in the online sessions.
- Guide students in developing community-oriented projects using ATL facilities and equipment.
- Make necessary arrangements for the successful organization of ATL Community Day on 21 April.
- Encourage students to present innovative and practical solutions for societal challenges.

This initiative will strengthen the spirit of innovation for social good and help connect students creativity with community development. All ATL schools principal are requested to make sure actively participation and organize the programme effectively.
